



## **Standard Conditions for Compliance with Temporary Outdoor Dining and Retail in Accordance with Executive Order 7MM:**

1. This permit is for a temporary use and the applicant shall return to the former approvals when Executive Order 7MM expires.
2. If this temporary permit leads to negative impacts on the surrounding area, including noise or parking impacts, the Zoning Official reserves the right to work with the businesses to collaboratively address and to revoke the permit if necessary.
3. Hours of patio opening are limited to 7:00 am to 11:00 pm, Friday and Saturday, and 7:00 am to 9:00 pm, Sunday – Thursday, in all districts where they are allowed.
4. No live music is allowed in the temporary patios.
5. The enclosure around the seating area that is adjacent to a parking/drive area shall remain in place to protect patrons and traffic.
6. Approval of outdoor activity on Borough property requires the sign off from the Streets Commissioner and/or Borough Warden.
7. Nothing in this temporary permit approval alleviates the applicant from separately complying with any and all requirements of the Fire Marshal, Ledge Light Health District, and the State requirements for, including but not limited to the sale of alcohol and the CT Guiding Rules for Re-Opening CT on May 20<sup>th</sup> – Sector Rules.
